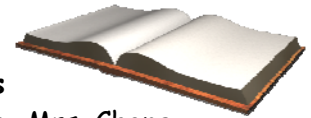

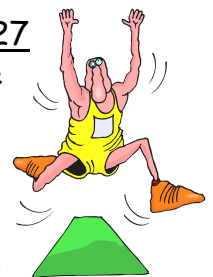

Field Day: THURSDAY, May 27

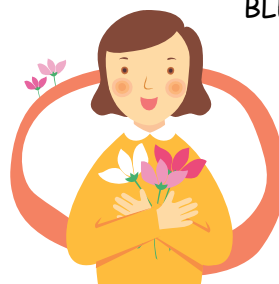
