CYO Meet of Champions: Track and Field

Congratulations to the St. Therese students who competed this spring on the Franciscan Montessori Earth School Track and Field team. Overall, the team finished 9th among 21 schools competing at the CYO Meet of Champions held at Jesuit last week. Our team of 60 athletes competed solidly against several much larger teams, several with over 150 members. The Cub Girls finished 3rd overall, Cub boys finished 12th, Cadet boys finished 8th and the Cadet girls finished 9th.

Olivia Gabriel set a new CYO record as she finished 1st in the Cub Girls 400 meter dash. She also finished 2nd in both the 100 and 200 meter events, and was on the Cub Girls 4x100 relay that finished 4th. Matt Vanoudenhaegen finished 8th overall in the 200 meter dash, and was part of the Cadet 4x100 relay team that finished 6th which also included Francesco Fischer. James Cory placed 5th in the Cadet Shot Put. Jackson Mackley was part of the Cub 4x400 relay that placed 7th. Also qualifying to compete in the Meet of Champions were Mariella Fischer, (javelin and shot put) Daniel Byington, (javelin and long jump) and Abby Nagel (800 meter). Francesco Fischer qualified to compete in the High Jump and 200



meter dash; Matt V in the 400 meter dash, and Nick Potter in the 1500 and javelin. Congratulations to all of the students who were part of this year's track season, achieving personal bests and having a great experience overall.
