The Preschool is located to the west of the MPC building. The curriculum is thematic and includes Language Arts, Science, Math, Religion and Social Studies. The preschoolers also have Music, Physical Education and Spanish classes.

- Mrs. Garneau, Preschool teacher, is a fully certified teacher and is assisted by a classroom aides, Mrs. Green and Mrs. Rothery
- Class size – 14-16 children
- Snacks are provided daily – sign up sheet for parents will be available in August.
- Parent helpers are welcome and will be used for activities, field trips, and parties.
- Parent orientation – in late August
- Drop off and pick up
 - Use the school parking lot, NO admittance through the 131st street door
 - The parent must walk their child to preschool class and sign them in.
 - Students should be picked up by the parent at the appropriate dismissal time of 11:20 or 3:30 p.m.
- The curriculum includes Spanish, PE, and Music.
 - We seek to provide an atmosphere of love and acceptance as we nurture children in their Christian beliefs.
 - Playground equipment on the preschool grounds, size appropriate, helps to develop their motor skills.
- Children must be able to feed themselves and be toilet trained by September 1st.

Your child will enter into the world of science, math, social studies, literature, computers, arts, poetry and music. We welcome you and your child to this exciting adventure called school.
