Little Flower Preschool Curriculum

The curriculum is thematic and includes Language Arts, Science, Math, Religion and Social Studies. The preschoolers also have Music, Physical Education and Spanish classes.

The Program is designed to help young children grow and gain knowledge through the use of many modes of learning.

- o Mrs. Horne, Preschool teacher, is a fully certified teacher and is assisted by classroom aides, Mrs. Green and Mrs. Rothery
- o The curriculum will develop their language and math skills with special emphasis on phonemic and memory skills.
- o We seek to provide an atmosphere of love and acceptance as we nurture children in their Christian beliefs.
- o Playground equipment on the preschool grounds, size appropriate, helps to develop their motor skills.
- o Children must be able to feed themselves and be toilet trained by August.



A FEW FACTS!

- The Preschool building is located on the west of the school gymnasium. Use the sidewalk on the north side of the gym to find your way to **Little Flower**.
- Class size – 16 children maximum
- Snacks are provided daily – there is a sign up sheet for parents
- Parent helpers are always welcome and will be used for activities, preparation of crafts at home, and parties.
- Parent orientation – in late August
- Drop off and pick up
 - o Parents must use the school parking lot, NO admittance through the 131st street door.
 - o Parents must walk their child to preschool class.
 - o Students should be picked up by the parent at the appropriate dismissal time of 11:20 or 3:30.
- The preschool program follows the K-8 school calendar, beginning in Sept. and ending in June. Exact dates to be announced.



TUITION COSTS
